Plugins



Feature-rich and also extensible through the use of <u>plugins</u>;

Indico relies on additional functionality by activating or deactivating available plugins

Users and administrators with the technical ability are invited to create their own plugins

CERN also have their own indico-plugins specific to their site and Indico instance

https://github.com/indico/indico-plugins-cern

For example, CERN have their own plugin for site access and tickets. Registrants are automatically given a pass for site






Indico can understand payment once enabled within Advanced Options





Privacy Policy



For each event, you have the option to define a 'Data Controller' and a privacy policy for this particular event

I would encourage you all to do this in the future





The Data Controller then appears on the main event page with contact details and the privacy notice.



Surveys



After an event, you can automatically schedule a survey to be sent to each participant (it is anonymous) and then results reviewed

The email can be customised in the same way as any other (Thanks to Eddie!)




Tickets and Badges

→ and then linking back to Indico






Check-in App
